### **TWO CHARGED IN AUGUST SHOOTING**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two men in connection with a shooting last August that left two people wounded.

**Jquan Johnson** (dob: 04-01-97) and **Juelues Judkins** (dob: 12-31-92) are charged with two counts of attempted first-degree murder (F2), two counts of attempted first-degree assault (F4), two counts of second-degree assault (F4), two counts of menacing (F5) and one count of illegal discharge of a weapon (F5).

The charges allege that on August 23, 2016, Johnson and Judkins were involved in a drive-by shooting in the 14000 block of Maxwell Place in which two people were shot and wounded.

Johnson has been released from custody on a \$100,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on December 8, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. for his second advisement. Judkins remains in custody; his bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 November 16, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. for his second advisement.
