LAWSON SENTENCED ON DUI

Former Denver Nugget player Ty Lawson appeared in Denver County Court this morning for sentencing on a DUI case that occurred last year.

Ty Lawson (dob: 11-03-87) pleaded guilty last fall to driving while ability impaired (M) and failing to drive in a single lane (TI).

He was sentenced this morning to one year of probation with monitored sobriety, 48 hours of community service, 52 hours of alcohol education and treatment. He must also pay fines and court costs of \$1,571.

Lawson was stopped on January 23, 2015 in the 3400 block of Park Avenue West after he was observed driving 60 mph in a 35 mph zone and passing another vehicle. He was arrested when the officer who stopped him noted slurred speech, stumbling and the odor of an alcoholic beverage.
