MAN CHARGED WITH INVASION OF PRIVACY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of using his cell phone to take photos from underneath a woman's skirt during a Denver Broncos game.

Jacob Magee (dob: 11-24-83) is charged with one count of *invasion of privacy for sexual gratification* (F6).

The charge alleges that on October 30, 2016, at Sports Authority Field at Mile High Stadium during a Broncos game, Magee was confronted by a woman who observed him using his cell phone to take pictures up her skirt without her consent. The man fled the scene but was later identified and taken into custody. Magee is currently a registered as a sex offender in Lafayette, CO.

Magee has been released from custody on a \$2,000.00 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 for his second advisement on December 15, 2016 at 1:30 p.m.
