MAN CHARGED IN FATAL SHOOTING OUTSIDE NIGHTCLUB

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of fatally shooting another man after a fight inside a Denver nightclub in October.

Harold Mortis (dob: 10-19-89) is charged with one count of first degree murder (F1) and one count of possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F4).

On October 16, 2016, Denver police responded to 2700 Larimer Street on a report of gunshots and found the victim, 29-year-old Tyrone Adair, Jr. Adair was transported to a local hospital but did not survive. Mortis was identified as a suspect and was arrested on December 11, 2016.

Mortis remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. His next court date has not yet been set.
