JURY RETURNS VERDICT IN SEXUAL ASSAULT TRIAL

A Denver jury has returned a not guilty verdict in a 1987 sexual assault case that was sent back to the district court for a new trial.

Clarence Moses (dob: 12-06-55) was acquitted today of all charges: first-degree sexual assault, second-degree assault and burglary.

The week-long trial concluded earlier today when the jury returned their not guilty verdict after about four hours of deliberations.

The case was prosecuted by Chief Deputy DA Bonnie Benedetti. “I want to thank the jury for their time and attention during the course of the trial. I am proud to work in an office that believes and stands by the victim, and in which investigative resources were provided that enabled us to challenge the credibility of the so-called confession by LC Jackson.” She added, “It was the right thing to allow a jury – not public opinion - to make the decision in this case.”
