### **WOMAN CHARGED IN PETITION FORGERY CASE**

A woman accused of forging multiple names and signatures on election petitions in Arapahoe County, Jefferson County, and Denver that were then submitted to the Colorado Secretary of State's Office, has been formally charged.

**Maureen Marie Moss** (dob: 05-16-71) is charged with 34 counts of forgery (F5).

The charges allege that between February 24, 2016 and March 31, 2016, Moss submitted at least 34 forged signatures to her employer, who in turn provided the petitions to the Keyser campaign, who then submitted them to the Colorado Secretary of State. The charges are the result of investigative work by the First, Second and Eighteenth Judicial District Attorney's Offices. There were seven identified victims in the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office (Arapahoe County), ten identified victims in 1<sup>st</sup> Judicial District (Jefferson County), and the remaining victims were from Denver. The Denver District Attorney's Office is handling the case with the assistance of the other prosecutors' offices based solely on the Colorado Secretary of State's Office being located in the City and County of Denver.

Moss was formally charged yesterday, and a warrant for her arrest has been issued. However, at this time she remains at large. Anyone with information about her whereabouts is asked to call the non-emergency number for their local law enforcement agency.
