MAN CHARGED WITH BURGLARY AND THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in a series of burglaries, including one that resulted in an officer-involved shooting on February 27, 2016.

Alfonso Padilla (dob: 04-18-90) is charged with four counts of *second-degree burglary* (F3) and two counts of *theft* (F6).

The charges allege that Padilla burglarized four homes between February 5 and February 27, 2016, stealing numerous items.

Padilla is in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, March 15, 2016, at 8 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
