### **MAN CHARGED IN LO DO SHOOTING**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting into a vehicle in LoDo during let-out, injuring several people.

**Nghia Trong Tran** (dob: 04-01-85) is charged with *attempted murder* (F2), *first-degree assault* (F3), two counts of *second-degree assault* (F4), *attempted second-degree assault* (F5), and six counts of *illegal discharge of a firearm* (F5).

The charges allege that on April 24, 2016, at about 1:45 a.m., Tran was involved in an altercation near 14<sup>th</sup> and Market Streets and that he fired multiple gunshots into a vehicle, injuring three people.

Tran has been released from custody on a \$50,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on May 17, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
