CHARGES FILED IN 2006 COLD CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in a cold case sexual assault dating back nearly a decade.

Isaias Villa (dob: 10-31-85) is charged with two counts of sexual assault (F3 and F4).

The charges allege that in August 2006, Villa took a 14-year-old girl to a party, where she became intoxicated, and he then took her to his home and sexually assaulted her. The case was unsolved until Villa was identified as a suspect through a DNA match last November.

Villa was already in custody on an unrelated matter, and remains in custody. His bond is set at \$50,000 on this case. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, March 29, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. to be advised of the charges.

This is the 116th cold case filing in Denver, and is the result of work by members of Denver's Cold Case Project.
