### **MAN FOUND GUILTY OF FELONY MURDER**

A man accused in the murder of 61-year-old Samuel Grady in early May 2015, has been found guilty by a Denver Jury.

**Derek Webb** (11-18-86) was found guilty of two counts of *felony murder* (F1), *burglary* (F3) and *aggravated robbery* (F3). The jury deliberated for two days before returning the verdicts late last week.

On May 6, 2015, Webb along with two other men went to the victim's home in the 4900 block of Green Court, shot him, and then stole his wallet and his truck.

Co-defendant **Chad Baluska** (dob: 11-25-76) submitted a guilty plea to one charge of *second-degree murder* (F1) and will be sentenced on January 06, 2017, in Denver District Courtroom 4G.

Co-defendant **Eric Fuhs** (dob: 05-07-90) was found guilty of *first-degree murder* (F1), *burglary* (F3), and *aggravated robbery* (F3) and was sentenced to life in prison without parole on October 17, 2016.

The case was prosecuted by Denver Deputy District Attorney Anita Drasan and Chief Deputy District Attorney Chris Penny. Webb faces life in prison without parole when he is sentenced on December 16, 2016, in Denver District Courtroom 4G.
