MAN CHARGED IN 2nd ROBBERY OF SAME BANK

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has charged a man in connection with a second robbery of the same bank.

Paul Brennan (dob: 11-17-1958) is charged with one count of *aggravated robbery-gun* (F3). The new charge was filed yesterday, March 13.

Brennan was charged on February 27, 2017, with the March 26, 2016, robbery of the 1st Bank located at 275 S. Federal Boulevard. The new charge alleges that on December 2, 2015, Brennan robbed a bank teller at the same bank. A teller who witnessed the March 2016 robbery of thought she recognized the robber as the person who robbed the bank in December 2015. The second robbery resulted in Denver Police issuing a “Crimestoppers” bulletin. After further investigation, Denver Police obtained an arrest warrant for aggravated robbery in April 2016. On February 24, 2017, Denver Police were notified by the Weston Police Department in Weston, Massachusetts that Brennan had been taken into custody on an unrelated matter and learned of the active Denver arrest warrant. Brennan was returned to Denver and placed in custody in Denver city jail on March 8, 2017.

Brennan’s bond is set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 for 2nd advisement on the new charge on March 15, 2017, at 8:30 a.m.
