### **MAN CHARGED IN 2016 BANK ROBBERY**

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has charged a man wanted in connection with a March 2016 bank robbery.

**Paul Brennan** (dob: 11-17-1958) is charged with one count of *aggravated robbery-gun* (F3). The charge was filed on February 27, 2017.

The charge alleges that on March 26, 2016, Brennan robbed a bank teller at the 1<sup>st</sup> Bank located at 275 S. Federal Boulevard, then fled the bank. A fellow teller thought she recognized the robber as the person who robbed her at the same bank in December 2015. Denver Police issued a “Crimestoppers” bulletin in March 2016. After further investigation, Denver Police obtained an arrest warrant for aggravated robbery in April 2016. On February 24, 2017, Denver Police were notified by the Weston Police Department in Weston, Massachusetts that Brennan had been taken into custody on an unrelated matter and learned of the active Denver arrest warrant. The Denver District Attorney’s Office requested through Denver Police that Brennan be held by Massachusetts authorities pending the issuance of an “AT LARGE” warrant, which was issued February 27, 2017.

Brennan is expected to be returned to Denver within the month for prosecution.
