FORMER CDOT AUDITOR CHARGED WITH THEFT, OTHER CHARGES

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has formally charged the former Audit Director of the Colorado Department of Transportation with theft and other charges.

Christopher Wedor (dob: 10-18-1982) is charged with one count of *theft* (F4), two counts of *identity theft* (F4), one count of *computer crime* (F4), six counts of *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4), and seven counts of *forgery* (F5). Charges were filed July 11, and Wedor turned himself in to authorities yesterday afternoon.

Wedor is accused of theft of over \$20,000 dollars from the Colorado Department of Transportation between May and December 2016 by charging personal items to his state issued credit card and to the credit cards of three subordinates. Wedor allegedly purchased gift cards, electronics, software, and other items.

A court appearance date has not yet been scheduled.
