MAN CHARGED IN NEW YEAR’S DAY MURDER

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has formally charged a man accused in the shooting death of a 35-year-old man at a Loretto Heights apartment complex on New Year’s Day.

Aaron A. Espinosa (dob: 08-03-91) is charged with one count of first degree murder after deliberation (F1), three counts of attempt to commit murder in the first degree (F2), and three counts of felony menacing (F5) in connection with the death of Hugo Ramirez, age 35.

Espinosa is in custody at the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. Espinosa is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5D on January 13, 2017, at 8:30 for first advisement.
