**WOMAN SENTENCED IN ELECTION PETITIONS FORGERY CASE**

A woman who pleaded guilty on November 17, 2016, to two counts of forgery (F5) relating to election petition signatures was sentenced today in Denver District Court.

**Maureen Marie Moss** (dob: 05-16-71) was sentenced to four years probation on each count and 250 hours of community service.

Moss was charged in June 2016, with forging multiple names and signature on election petitions in Arapahoe County, Jefferson County and Denver. In February and March 2016, Moss submitted numerous forged petition signatures to her employer, who in turn provided the petitions to a political campaign, who then submitted them to the Colorado Secretary of State.

The case was the result of investigative work by the First, Second and Eighteenth Judicial District Attorney's Offices.
