TWO MEN SENTENCED IN DEMARCUS WARE HOME BURGLARY

Two men charged with burglary and theft from the home of retired Denver Broncos great Demarcus Ware in October 2016 were sentenced yesterday.

Billy McCaslin (dob: 01-26-1976) and **Sergio Irreza** (dob: 02-17-1985) each pleaded guilty in April to one count of *second degree burglary* (F4). The original two counts of *second degree burglary* (F3) and *theft* (F4) against each were dismissed as part of the plea.

McCaslin was sentenced to 60 days in jail plus two years' probation; Irreza was sentenced to 30 days in jail plus two years' probation.

McCaslin and Irreza broke into Ware's home in the Cherry Creek neighborhood on October 24, 2016. They stole approximately \$40,000 of valuables, including Mr. Ware's Super Bowl 50 championship ring. Most of the property was later recovered, including the ring. Per the plea agreement, if there remains any outstanding loss claimed by the victim, the DA's office reserves the right to obtain restitution.
