MAN GETS LIFE IN PRISON FOR 2015 MURDER

A man convicted in February in the shooting death of a man in September 2015 was sentenced Wednesday afternoon in Denver District Court.

Jesse L. Oliver (11-06-1982) was found guilty in February after a six-day trial of *first degree murder* (F1) and *first degree assault-deadly weapon* (F3) in the shooting death of 34-year-old Bobby Brown and the wounding of a teenage girl. He was sentenced yesterday to life in prison without the possibility of parole for the murder conviction and to 32 years in prison for the assault conviction, the sentences to run consecutively.

On September 16, 2015, Oliver shot Mr. Brown to death and wounded the teenage girl outside of an apartment building at 13890 Albrook Drive. Oliver was arrested at the scene.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorneys Phil Reinert and Effie Antonopoulos.
