SUSPECTS CHARGED IN MULTIPLE BURGLARIES/THEFTS

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has charged several defendants in a string of burglaries and thefts.

Luis Ortega (dob: 06-17-1994), **Anessa Suazo** (08-12-1998), and **Anthony Wilcox** (dob: 06-08-1995) are each charged with two counts of *second degree burglary* (F3), one count of *attempted second degree burglary* (F4), one count of *first degree criminal trespass* (F5), and two counts of *theft* (M1). Ortega and Suazo were charged on April 18; Wilcox was charged on April 13.

The charges allege that on March 25, 2017, between 3:00 and 6:30 p.m. at four separate locations the trio burglarized or attempted to burglarize three residences, in the 3100 block of E. Kentucky Avenue, 800 block of S. Garfield Street, and 1400 block of S. Eudora Street, and theft from a vehicle in the 3000 block of E. 1st Avenue. Wilcox was arrested April 11, Ortega on April 13, and Suazo on April 14.

In a separate case, **Wilcox** and another co-defendant **Jonathan Avila** (dob: 12-25-1992) are each charged with one count of *second degree burglary* (F3) in connection with the alleged burglary of a residence in the 1500 block of S. York Street the afternoon of March 30, 2017. The two suspects were allegedly in the possession of a stolen vehicle at the time. Avila was arrested, and the vehicle recovered, by Westminster police on March 31. Wilcox and Avila were charged with this burglary on April 13.

Ortega and Suazo are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 20, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. for 2nd advisement.

Wilcox is scheduled to appear for both cases in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on May 11, 2017, at 8:00 a.m. for a preliminary hearing, and Avila in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 20, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. for 2nd advisement and 8:00 a.m. on May 11 for the preliminary hearing.
