**MAN SENTENCED IN FATAL 2015 CHRISTMAS EVE CRASH**

A man charged with *vehicular homicide* (F4) for a crash on I-25 at Colfax Avenue in the early morning hours of Christmas Eve, 2015 was sentenced yesterday in Denver District Court to eight years in prison.

Jorge Robles (dob: 09-07-1993) pled guilty on November 17, 2016 to one count of vehicular homicide and to two counts of aggravated motor vehicle theft (F6). Yesterday's sentence includes the statutory maximum of six years for vehicular homicide and a consecutive sentence of two years for the aggravated motor vehicle theft charges.

Robles was driving a stolen vehicle that caused a two-vehicle collision, resulting in the death of 52-year old Jeffrey Koontz. Robles was arrested on June 9, 2016.
