**MAN CHARGED IN STABBING DEATH AT HOMELESS SHELTER**

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has formally charged a man in connection with the stabbing death of another man last week at a homeless shelter.

**Timothy Lovelace** (dob: 03-29-1983) is charged with one count of *murder in the first degree* (F1). The charge was filed today.

Lovelace is accused of stabbing 45-year-old Gordon Evert to death on May 11, 2017, at a homeless shelter at 1680 N. Sherman Street. Lovelace and the victim were allegedly engaged in a conversation near the victim's bunk when Lovelace left the area and returned with a chef's knife and began stabbing Mr. Evert. Lovelace was arrested on site.

Lovelace is being held in custody without bond in the Denver city jail. His next court appearance date, in Denver District Court, has not yet been scheduled.
