**SEVEN CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH ATTEMPTED ROBBERY/MURDER**

Denver District Attorney Beth McCann has formally charged six adults and a juvenile in connection with the shooting death of a man in an alleged attempted robbery of the victim at his home.

**William Webb** (dob: 04-14-1992), **Mikie Tarango** (dob: 03-13-1997), **Quenon Glaspy** (dob: 06-12-1997), **Savannah Leisegang** (dob: 08-04-1999), and **Kylan Sapp** (dob: 09-22-1995) are each charged with one count of *murder in the first degree* (F1) and two counts of *attempt to commit aggravated robbery (U.S. currency, marijuana, codeine, and methylenedioxy methamphetamine)* (F4). Charges against Webb and Tarango were filed October 10, charges against Glaspy and Leisegang were filed October 27, and charges against Sapp were filed October 30, 2017.

**Tyjon Villa** (dob 03-20-1996) is charged with two counts of *murder in the first degree* (F1) and two counts of *attempt to commit aggravated robbery (U.S. currency, marijuana, codeine, and methylenedioxy methamphetamine)* (F4). Charges against Villa were filed October 27, 2017.

Additionally, a 17-year-old female juvenile was arrested in Houston, TX last Thursday and charged Friday in Denver Juvenile Court with one count of *accessory to murder* (F4).

On September 25, 2017, the victim, 24-year-old Dominique Cozy, was shot at his home in the 2200 block of S. Delaware Street. The seven defendants are allegedly variously involved in the planning or attempted execution of a robbery of the home, and the subsequent shooting death of Mr. Cozy. No further information is available at this time, as the arrest warrants for all seven defendants are currently suppressed.

All defendants are in custody. Webb, Tarango and Leisegang are scheduled to appear on December 1, 2017, at 1:30 p.m. in district courtroom 5C for preliminary hearings. Villa, Sapp and Glaspy are scheduled to appear on January 26, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in district courtroom 5C for preliminary hearings.
