<b>SUPPORTING AFFIDAVIT FOR AT LARGE ARREST WARRANT</b>	

I, Detective BRIAN C LANG, of lawful age do swear upon my oath to the facts set forth below and on three continuation pages:

Your affiant, Detective BRIAN C LANG, a Police Officer with the Denver Police Department, was assigned to investigate allegations of SEXUAL ASSAULT in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(5), C.R.S. (F2), SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING in violation of 18-3-302(1),(3), C.R.S. (F2), SEXUAL ASSAULT in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(4), C.R.S. (F3), FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY in violation of 18-4-202(1), C.R.S. (F3) and ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE in violation of 18-3-203(1)(b), C.R.S. (F4) by JEROME L LUCAS against [REDACTED] on DPD offense number 2019185154.

Your Affiant obtained the following information by personal observations, interviews, witnesses, discussions with fellow officers and by reviewing official police reports of the Denver Police Department.

On March 24, 2019 at 1528 hours The Denver Police Department's Communications Bureau received a 911 call from phone # [REDACTED]. The call was listed as a sexual assault in progress. The information provided indicated the sexual assault occurred at [REDACTED] Arizona Ave, [REDACTED], (which is in the City and County of Denver). The call was placed by [REDACTED] and he said his friend, who was later identified as [REDACTED] came to his house and said she had just been raped and her house had just been burglarized. [REDACTED] also reported that [REDACTED] car had been stolen. [REDACTED] vehicle was a 2017 Toyota Corolla with Colorado license plate [REDACTED] and Vehicle Identification Number V.I.N. # [REDACTED].

Your Affiant spoke with [REDACTED] and she said she came home after going to the gym. [REDACTED] said she got home from the gym and was supposed to meet a friend around 2 o'clock. [REDACTED] said she took a shower and then went downstairs and went to take out the recycling. [REDACTED] said she was rushing to the recycling bin because her container was overflowing, and this is why she did not

get her keys and lock her door. [REDACTED] said she left her main door open but the screen door closed. [REDACTED] said it was broad daylight and said it was around 1:20 (in the afternoon). [REDACTED] said the recycling is less than a block away, a straight shot, if she turns around she can see her house. [REDACTED] estimated it was a minute and a half that she was gone to take out the recycling.

[REDACTED] said when she came back inside she smelt smoke and said it smelled like someone had been smoking inside her residence. [REDACTED] said she went upstairs in her residence and said it smelt smoky up there as well. [REDACTED] said she then went downstairs and when she got to the bottom of the stairs she saw a man pop out from the other side of the room. [REDACTED] said he was black and he was big. [REDACTED] said he was wearing red and was racing towards her. [REDACTED] said she was disoriented by seeing someone inside her house. [REDACTED] said he punched her immediately in the head, 3-4 times and she said she fell to the ground. [REDACTED] said she put her hands in the air and looked down and he was saying not to look at him. [REDACTED] said he asked her where the money was. [REDACTED] told him she did not have a lot of money but said she had a check card and he could take it.

[REDACTED] said he then asked about her security cameras and what she had on her front door. [REDACTED] said she told him it was a Ring doorbell, but the battery was dead. [REDACTED] said he then asked her where her gun was over and over. [REDACTED] said she handed him all the money she had and check books she had in a drawer. [REDACTED] said he then went through her jewelry and asked her where her good jewelry was.

[REDACTED] said she did not remember exactly how she got to her bed but she remembered being face down and she said he blindfolded her and tied her up. [REDACTED] said she did not know what she was being blindfolded with but saw a face mask she sleeps in and maybe a red dress tied around her eyes. [REDACTED] said she was tied up with computer cords, phone cords and a cord [REDACTED] that was used for her legs. [REDACTED] said he then had her crawl to the bathroom.

[REDACTED] said when she was crawling into the bathroom she could not see, and she said he was pushing her. [REDACTED] said he mentioned he did not want to get his DNA on her. [REDACTED] said after she crawled in the bathroom the male left for a while.

[REDACTED] said he came to the bathroom and told her to go to the bedroom. [REDACTED] said she crawled on the ground into the guest bedroom. [REDACTED] said he told her to get on the bed and she said she laid on the bed for a long time. [REDACTED] said he came and shoved a sock in her throat. [REDACTED] said she asked him not to gag her and then he asked her for tape. [REDACTED] said she was on her stomach and he used scissors to cut her clothes off because he needed to get his DNA off her. [REDACTED] said after he cut her clothes off of her he nicked her with the scissors and she said "owe" and he said sorry.

[REDACTED] said he then asked her where her lube was, and she told him she has a bunch of lotions by her bed. [REDACTED] said he went and then came back. [REDACTED] said she does not think he said anything and she said he put his penis inside her and said it was her vagina. [REDACTED] said it was quick and said it was like 50 seconds. [REDACTED] said he poured vodka all over her and she thought it was gasoline and she thought he was going to light her on fire. [REDACTED] said he told her he needed to do

that to wipe off the DNA. [REDACTED] said she told him that it burned, and he told her she is just going to have to go through this "mommy" and said it is going to be quick.

[REDACTED] said he left and then she could hear her trunk opening and closing. [REDACTED] said he told her he will be back in 5 minutes and not to move and for her to wait 20 minutes and she could call the police. [REDACTED] said she waited and he never came back. [REDACTED] said she moved her hands and got the blind fold off. [REDACTED] said she was able to get her shoe unzipped and got one foot out. [REDACTED] said she got her other foot out and then got her hands out. [REDACTED] said she was naked at this point other than her underwear were at the bottom of her leg and her socks were on.

[REDACTED] said she looked out the window and saw her car was gone. [REDACTED] said she started to go downstairs and saw her couches were barricading her front door. [REDACTED] said she went to the back door and saw her garage door was open and she ran out with no pants or underwear. [REDACTED] was able to get to her friend's house where 9-1-1 was called.

[REDACTED] further discussed the incident and said when she came back from taking out her recycling she noticed the smoke smell, but the house was the same. [REDACTED] said she does not smoke, her boyfriend does not smoke and none of her friends that have been to her house smoke.

[REDACTED] said only the right side of her face was punched and said he did not kick or bite her.

[REDACTED] said nothing else physically happened other than the scissors cutting her, raping her and pouring alcohol on her.

[REDACTED] said when she was first on the bed she was laying on her stomach. [REDACTED] said he then had her get on her hands and knees. [REDACTED] said she was facing the window on the bed and he was behind her, standing. [REDACTED] said she thinks he was holding her hips, (while sexually assaulting her). [REDACTED] said it did not feel like he had a condom on. [REDACTED] said the sex assault stopped because she thought he finished but she did not feel anything wet in her. [REDACTED] said she was only vaginally raped, which [REDACTED] said happened about an hour and a half into him ransacking the house.

[REDACTED] was transported to Denver Health Medical Center for treatment and for a sexual assault exam. The sexual assault exam was completed by [REDACTED]. During the sexual assault exam buccal, vaginal, external vulva and cervical swabs were collected from [REDACTED]. The sexual assault exam also noted that [REDACTED] had genital trauma and body trauma. The items collected during [REDACTED] sexual assault exam were placed in the Denver Police Department's Property Bureau as evidence under invoice #1038153 and were subsequently submitted to The Denver Police Department's Crime Laboratory for processing.

On March 24, 2019 at approximately 1732 hours The Denver Police Department's Crime Laboratory responded to the victim's address, [REDACTED] Arizona Ave. [REDACTED] (which is in the City and County of Denver) where the above incident took place. The victim, [REDACTED] signed consent to search her residence. Detective McIver 00117, Crime Scene Investigators McColm B13042, Verbrugge B14001 and Crime Scene Supervisor Fox B18108 assisted with

searching [REDACTED] residence.

During the search of the residence one "Maverick" cigarette butt and one cigarette filter were located submerged in the toilet bowl in the bathroom on the first level of the residence. These items were collected as evidence and were marked with Marker #7 and were then placed in the Denver Police Department's Property Bureau as evidence under invoice #1038117 item #2.

On March 28, 2019 at 1416 hours Your Affiant was notified by Forensic Supervisor Eric Duvall the following information:

- The male DNA profile obtained from "marker #7" "Maverick" "toilet bowl" (1038117-2-7) resulted in a CODIS hit to Jerome Lekendric Lucas (1/10/85). The CODIS hit was a match at 13 or more genetic loci. This male DNA profile is also included on the hips swabs (1038153-1E).

Your Affiant conducted a search of Jerome Lekendrick Lucas (01/10/85) and found he has several listed aliases, one of which is Lekendric Jerome Lucas. The alias Lekendric Jerome Lucas has an associated Colorado driver's license issued under P.I.N. #97-205-1239. Your Affiant found that both Jerome Lekendrick Lucas (01/10/85) and Lekendric Jerome Lucas (01/10/85) have social security number [REDACTED] listed.

Based on the foregoing, your affiant respectfully requests that an At Large Warrant be issued for the arrest of **JEROME L LUCAS, DOB: 01/10/1985** for **SEXUAL ASSAULT** in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(5), C.R.S. (F2), **SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING** in violation of 18-3-302(1),(3), C.R.S. (F2), **SEXUAL ASSAULT** in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(4), C.R.S. (F3), **FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY** in violation of 18-4-202(1), C.R.S. (F3) and **ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE** in violation of 18-3-203(1)(b), C.R.S. (F4).
