 I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 10/10/16 at 1841 am pm at or near the location of 4300 block of N Colorado Blvd., In the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

Statement of Probable Cause Affidavit for Arrest Warrant

Your affiant, Detective Steven D. Sloan #06129, has been a Police Officer for over 18 years. Your affiant was assigned to the Denver Police Department, Traffic Investigation Unit for over four years and currently holds this position.

On the evening of Monday, 10/10/2016 at approximately 1840 hours, your affiant responded to a five vehicle, fatal, hit and run traffic accident located in the 4300 block of N Colorado Blvd. This location was then and is now within the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

A white 2014 Dodge Challenger with Tennessee license plate T5572H was traveling south on N Colorado Blvd, at a high rate of speed, described as over 100 miles per hour, according to the independent witnesses. The Dodge Challenger was traveling in the left through lane at this time. The Dodge Challenger collided with a Toyota Prius that has Colorado license plate number [REDACTED] that was in front of the Dodge Challenger also in the left through lane traveling south at a reported speed of 40 miles per hour.

This collision caused the Toyota Prius to collide with an Acura that was in the center though lane and the Toyota Prius continued in a south west direction and collided with the cement barrier where it came to rest. The Dodge Challenger continued south on the center raised median, collided with a fixed street light pole and continued in a south west direction where it collided with a Volkswagen that was in the center through lane. This impact caused the Volkswagen to slide south west, leave the roadway and collide with a fence and a parked unoccupied Dodge van. The driver of the 2014 Dodge Challenger then fled on foot. The drivers of the Toyota Prius and Acura were transported to Denver Health Medical Center for treatment. At 1919 hours, the driver of the Toyota Prius, Ms. Ariel Berryman ([REDACTED]/1987), was pronounced deceased by Doctor Sam Smith.

While processing the scene, your affiant was contacted by Detective D. Washechek #04060. Detective Washechek stated that he had run a motor vehicle check on the Tennessee license plate number (T5572H) and found it listed to Tyler White. Using Accurint, he had located names and telephone numbers for family members, in Tennessee, for Tyler White and began calling and interviewing them over the telephone.

Detective Washechek found out from the family members contacted, that Tyler White is in Colorado currently and it was confirmed that the involved Dodge Challenger is the vehicle Tyler White should have in Colorado. Detective Washechek was able to track down a [REDACTED] of Tyler White, [REDACTED] in Leadville, Colorado and was able to make contact with him. Detective Washechek was able to obtain a photograph of Tyler White from [REDACTED] and responded to the scene with the photograph.

Denver Police Dispatch was notified by Denver Fire Dispatch that they were responding to City Park on a medical call. Two fishermen were at the lake fishing and observed a naked Black male in the center of the lake dancing on the statue/fountain. The male then entered the water and began trying to swim back to land. As this male arrived on shore and collapsed, the fishermen called 911.

Officer M. James #08047 and Officer Hancock #05004 were on scene of the collision and were given a copy of the photograph of Tyler White prior to responding to City Park and were able to identify that the naked male was Tyler White (10/01/1991), the owner and driver of the Dodge Challenger. Tyler White had made statements to Denver Health Paramedic Wooley in ambulance #71 that he had been involved in the accident and he had been smoking weed and he had been driving in excess of 90 miles per hour prior to the collision.

Denver Police DUI/DRE Officer A. Ma #13001 was requested to meet with Tyler White at Denver Health Medical Center. Officer Ma advised Tyler White of his *Constitutional Rights* at 2305 hours in the emergency room, Red 2. Tyler White spoke with Officer Ma and consented to having his blood drawn and tested for intoxication. The results of the blood testing are still pending.

Denver Police Detective's R. Kobernick #01054 and Detective Washechek arrived at Denver Health Medical Center and attempted to speak with Tyler White. Tyler White told the detective's, "[REDACTED]"

Tyler White was being held on an Investigative Hold for Vehicular Homicide.

On 10/13/2016 this case was presented by your affiant to George Poland, Chief Deputy District Attorney, with the Denver District Attorney's Office who accepted the charges. The accepted charges for filing against Tyler White were:

1. 18-3-106 (1)(b)(I) Vehicular Homicide F3
2. 18-3-106(1)(a) Vehicular Homicide F4
3. 42-4-1601(1)(2)(c) Leaving the scene of an accident involving death F3
4. 18-3-204(1)(a) Assault in the third degree M1.

On 10/11/2016, your affiant composed an Affidavit for Search Warrant to obtain and collect information from the Dodge Challenger Event Data Recorder (EDR). The Affidavit for Search Warrant was reviewed and approved by Chief Deputy District Attorney George Poland #13031 on 10/11/2016 at 1709 hours.

On 10/11/2016 at 1729 hours, The Honorable Judge Burd reviewed and approved the Affidavit for Search Warrant.

On 10/13/2016 at 1755 hours, your affiant executed the Search Warrant and retrieved the Event Data Recorder and collected the evidence it contained. The information was printed and presented to Detective David Carroll #94026 for interpretation as he has been trained and is qualified to read the evidence collected.

On 10/14/2016 at approximately 1400 hours Detective David Carroll found that at .8 seconds prior to the collision, Tyler White was driving the Dodge Challenger at 100% full accelerator pedal and was traveling at 134 miles per hour on N Colorado Blvd that is a posted 35 mile per hour zone.

On 10/23/2016 Tyler White posted the \$25,000 bond amount in County Court under case number 16CR6631 for the above listed charges and was released from jail.

On 10/26/2016 the information from the EDR report was provided to the assigned Deputy District Attorney Shannon O'Connor.

On 10/10/16, the date of the fatal collision, Tyler White demonstrated through his driving actions an attitude of universal malice manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life and knowingly engaged in conduct which creates a grave risk of death to a person, or persons that caused death to Ms. Ariel Berryman.

Deputy District Attorney Shannon O'Connor reviewed the additional information and determined that the pending County Court charges shall be dismissed upon his arrest and the following charges will be filed in District Court.

Your affiant was requested to complete an Arrest Warrant for Tyler M White (10/01/1991) for the above charges.

At the request of the Denver District Attorney's Office, your affiant is also requesting a No Bond Hold for Tyler White, pursuant to the charges.
