I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 08/26/2019 at 6:14 pm at or near the location of N FEDERAL BLVD / W 14TH AVE in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

[On 08/26/2019 at approximately 1814 hours, the RO responded to N Federal Blvd / W 14th Ave on the report of a carjacking. The RO contacted victim #1, [REDACTED]. This address is in the city and county of Denver, Colorado.

The investigation revealed that on 08/26/2019 at approximately 1811 hours, the victim stops the bus (Colorado plate# [REDACTED]) at the Southbound N Federal Blvd bus stop #F and opens the door. The defendant, later identified as Solomon David Garcia 10/19/1982 (Colorado PIN [REDACTED]), gets on the bus and says to victim #1, "[REDACTED]". The defendant repeats this statement again, grabs victim #1 and forces victim #1 out of the driver seat, then forces victim #1 off the bus. The defendant then flees in the bus traveling Southbound on N Federal Blvd.

At approximately 1819 hours, the defendant crashes the bus at W 6th Ave Frontage Rd (WB) / N Lowell Blvd. Witness [REDACTED] and Victim #2, [REDACTED] observe the defendant driving the bus, crash, and observe the defendant exiting the bus. The defendant exits the bus and goes to Victim #2's residence, [REDACTED]. This address is also in the city and county of Denver, Colorado. The defendant approaches victim #2 and says "[REDACTED]?" When victim #2 replies no, the defendant states that he has [REDACTED] #2. The defendant attempts to enter victim #2's home at [REDACTED] Lowell Blvd in order to get the keys from inside the house. Victim #2 fights with the defendant and the defendant is unsuccessful in obtaining Victim #2's keys.

The defendant then runs away and approaches Victim #3, [REDACTED], who is driving a [REDACTED] (Colorado Plate# [REDACTED]) Westbound on the W 6th Ave Frontage Rd. The defendant opens the driver side door, puts his hand into Victim #3's stomach and tells Victim #3 he will [REDACTED]. Victim #3 believed that the defendant was pushing a gun into her stomach and got out the car. The defendant then enters Victim #3's car and fled Westbound on the W 6th Ave Frontage Road.

At approximately 1831 hours, Officers locate Victim #3's vehicle that was involved in an accident at N Sheridan Blvd / W 1st Ave. The defendant was in the driver seat of Victim #3's car. Officers detained the defendant without incident. A show up for identification was conducted and the defendant was positively identified by Victim #2 as the same individual who was driving the bus and attempt to rob her. The defendant was positively identified by Victim #3 as the same individual who robbed her of her vehicle.

The RO reviewed video footage of the robbery of Victim #1 and observed the suspect wearing blue jeans, a black, long sleeved, button up shirt, and a tan hat. The suspect also appeared to have a dark colored beard. The RO responded to W 1st Ave / N Sheridan Blvd and observed the defendant's pants were blue jeans, his shirt was a long sleeved, black button up, and the defendant had a dark colored beard. The RO also observed a tan baseball cap on the passenger floorboard of the stolen [REDACTED] that appeared similar to the hat the suspect was wearing in the video.

The defendant was identified via Morpho Fingerprint reader.

The defendant was placed on an investigative hold for Aggravated Robbery.]
