Your affiant, Detective RANDY S HINRICHER, a Police Officer with the Denver Police Department, was assigned to investigate allegations of CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE in violation of 18-3-102(1)(a);18-2-101, C.R.S. (F2), ASSAULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE in violation of 18-3-202(1)(a), C.R.S. (F3), FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY in violation of 18-4-202(1), C.R.S. (F3), AGGRAVATED ROBBERY in violation of 18-4-302(1)(b), C.R.S. (F3), MENACING in violation of 18-3-206(1)(a)/(b), C.R.S. (F5), AGGRAVATED CRUELTY TO ANIMALS in violation of 18-9-202(1.5)(b), C.R.S. (F6) and CRIME OF VIOLENCE in violation of 18-1.3-406(2)(a)(I)(A), C.R.S. (se) by DANDRE PERKINS against and DPD offense number 2019435748.

On 07-11-2019 at about 2236 hrs, Denver police officers were dispatched to the area of Park Avenue West and Larimer Street on a Robbery in progress. When officers arrived on scene they found a female holding a dog that was covered in blood. The female holding the dog, identified as the control officers that the dog was stabbed. While officers were talking to the had been stabbed multiple times. Officers called an ambulance for the male victim, identified as the control of the contr

Prior to an ambulance arriving, victim insisted on returning to his apartment to check on his other dog. Corporal Chris BLANCHARD 14003 accompanied back to his apartment where the other dog was found to be okay. Corporal BLANCHARD reported seeing "blood droplets all over the floor" inside of the apartment. Shortly thereafter, a DHMC ambulance arrived and transported victim to DHMC. Officer Cody LANE 18067 rode in the ambulance and interviewed victim. He told Officer LANE that five black males and a Hispanic female stopped by his apartment to "hang out". He knew one of the male suspects as but didn't provide names for the others at this time.

He didn't realize that he had been stabbed A serious bodily injury report was completed by DHMC Physician Ameera HAMMIEL who reported that sustained serious bodily injury by "a substantial risk of death". The victim's dog was transported to an emergency care facility for treatment. The dog survived but his injuries were severe. A knife was collected inside of the victim's apartment by Officer Nathaniel TROBEE and placed into the Denver Police Department Property Bureau as evidence under invoice #1059265. On 07-12-2019, YOUR AFFIANT was assigned this case for follow-up investigation. YOUR AFFIANT went to DHMC and met with victim He told YOUR AFFIANT that he and were at his apartment when he Shortly thereafter, a female and four other black males arrived. He told YOUR AFFIANT that they were all talking when he got up to get a glass of water. He had his back turned when he heard his dog yelping, so he went to turn around and was punched. He didn't realize that he was also being stabbed. He told YOUR AFFIANT that that one of the suspects wearing a doo rag had stabbed the dog. The dog then ran out and followed the dog. He then made his way outside to check on I and dog. Due to his condition, agreed to meet with YOUR AFFIANT and provide all the information on the suspects when he was released from the hospital. YOUR AFFIANT obtained HALO video from a camera at Park Avenue West and Larimer Street for the time frame in question. The video showed a park in the 1200 blk of Park Avenue West at about 2208 hrs and then at 2216 hrs, a arrived and parked two spaces in front of the Four black males got out of the and a white or Hispanic female and a lighter complexed male got out of the The two groups could be seen meeting up and then making their way to the victim's apartment. Approximately 16 minutes later, all the parties from both vehicles could be seen running back to their vehicles with one of the black males carrying what appeared was last seen going south bound on Larimer Street and the to be was last seen going west on Park Avenue West. YOUR AFFIANT obtained surveillance video footage from it showed a some of the suspects standing at the entrance of the building while awaiting to let them in. (Not all of the suspects could be seen because they are out of camera view.) Later the suspects can be seen fleeing back to their cars. On 07-22-2019, YOUR AFFIANT received an email from who provided the names of four of the six suspects that were in his apartment. D'Andre

YOUR AFFIANT also met with AFFIANT that she and and asked if he and some other people could stop by. Shortly thereafter, and the others arrived. (James PERKINS) suddenly stabbed the dog for no apparent reason. The same suspect then turned the knife on her and held it close to her face. At the same time, and the unknown female left the apartment while two of the other suspects (D'Andre PERKINS and Davon REED) assaulted with knives and the third suspect (unknown) indicated that she saw drop to the floor and he appeared to be knocked out. At that point, the suspect with the doo rag (James PERKINS) ran over to the other suspects standing over Moments later, two suspects (James PERKINS and D'Andre PERKINS) ran to the closet and grabbed belonging to and all the suspects fled out of the apartment. The
YOUR AFFIANT compiled separate photo arrays for suspects D'Andre PERKINS 11-19-1998, James PERKINS 11-16-1998 and Davon REED 05-19-1999 and on 07-31-2019 Detective Jessica SANCHEZ 07064 showed them to victim positively identified all three as the suspects that assaulted and robbed him. The fourth suspect is unknown, currently. Based on the foregoing, your affiant respectfully requests that an At Large Warrant be issued for the arrest of DANDRE PERKINS, DOB: 11/19/1998 for CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE in violation of 18-3-102(1)(a);18-2-101, C.R.S.
