I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 11/23/2019 at 11:36 am at or near the location of 2701 BLAKE ST in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

[On 11/23/19 at approximately 1123 hours, officers responded to 2701 Blake St., in the city and county of Denver, State of Colorado, on a report of shots fired. Officers arrived on scene and heard more shots from the area. Officers observed the defendant, later identified by Colorado Commercial Driver's License as Bryan Lambert DOB 06/10/80, with a smith and wesson MP15 AR 15 rifle in his hand. Lambert placed the rifle, one 30 round magazine with 30 .223 rounds in the magazine, one 30 round magazine with 20 .223 rounds in the magazine, and one 10 round magazine with 10 .223 rounds in the magazine on the ground near him. Officers placed Lambert in custody. Lambert was contacted just east of Coors Field and near several multi level apartment buildings that were occupied. Upon an area search of the parking garage at 2701 Blake St officers discovered 9 spent .223 shell casings and damage to two different vehicles. Officers also reviewed video surveillance footage from Coors Field security and observed Lambert firing the rifle on different levels of the parking structure and leaning over the edge and pointing the rifle into traffic in the 2700 block of Blake St. The vehicles that were struck by bullet holes were investigated by officers. One vehicle (CO/ [REDACTED]) is a [REDACTED]. It had damage to the driver's side window, driver's side mirror and protective cover, multiple bullet holes in the driver's side door and frame to the door, passenger side door, and passenger side window. The second vehicle (CO/ [REDACTED]) is a [REDACTED]. It had damage to the driver's side metal door, panels, windshield, passengers side window, and passenger side door. The damage on each vehicle is estimated to be over \$1,000.00. The damage to each vehicle was caused by bullet holes into the vehicles. Lambert did this without the consent of the registered owner of either vehicle. [REDACTED] residing at [REDACTED] Blake St [REDACTED] stated she observed a party with a rifle pacing and occasionally aimed the rifle over the edge of the parking structure. [REDACTED] later identified Lambert as the person she observed in the parking garage. [REDACTED] also stated that she heard multiple shots fired from Lambert. Based on these facts Lambert has violated Colorado Revised Statute 18-12-302 (1)(C) Large Capacity Magazines Prohibited, 18-12-106 Prohibited Use of a Weapon, 18-4-501 Criminal Mischief, and 42-5-103 Tampering with a Motor Vehicle.]
