I, Detective Todd Cole (07012), the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above-named person(s), are the following:

Your Affiant obtained the following information from personal observations, interviewing witnesses and reviewing police reports of fellow officers. Your Affiant relates the following in support of an arrest warrant.

**01/08/20**

On this date, approximately 2141 hours, at 330 South Dayton Street Denver, Colorado at the Lightshade Dispensary, 5 unknown masked suspects entered the store and pointed handguns at victims

[REDACTED] demanding cash and merchandise. During the robbery, one of the suspects fired a shot inside the store. The suspects fled the location in a dark colored Pontiac sedan.

Detective Raquel Lopez (08016) responded to the location to assist in processing the crime scene and was assigned this robbery for follow up investigation.

Officers reviewed the Lightshade Dispensary video surveillance and observed that on the exterior video surveillance camera the 5 suspects pull up in a dark, possibly maroon sedan. As two of the suspects exit the right rear passenger door, a white plastic grocery bag is observed falling onto the ground from the suspects right rear passenger seat area. After the suspects rob the store, they all get back into the sedan and drive off, leaving the same white grocery bag on the ground.

The Denver Police Crime Lab responded and processed the business for latent prints and other items of evidence. Several items of evidence were collected, including the white, plastic grocery bag.

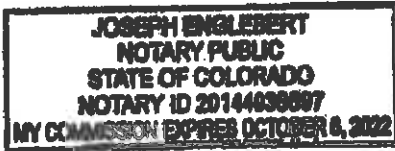
