Denver DA Resolves Four Criminal Cases Against Serial Sex Offender Agustin Guerrero

DENVER—Denver District Attorney Beth McCann today announced that four separate criminal cases against Agustin Guerrero (age 35) were resolved on Friday September 11, 2020. Denver District Court Judge Karen Brody presided over the sentencing. The cases are 19CR00467, 19CR01015, 19CR10160 and 19CR02327. Mr. Guerrero attacked and stalked women he did not know in the Denver Highlands neighborhood.

“Agustin Guerrero is a serial sex offender who pled guilty to stalking, indecent exposure, criminal attempt to commit sexual assault and robbery, said DA McCann. “As trial schedules recover from the coronavirus interruption, I am pleased that we can help the court make efficient use of its time and resources by resolving these four cases against Agustin Guerrero.”

Prosecutors believe that there are likely many more victims and want the public to know that Guerrero was sentenced to serve a total of 12-years in prison, followed by 10-years of sex offender intensive supervised probation and lifetime sex offender registration upon his release.
