



**AFFIDAVIT AND APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT

Sean Edward Landrock, 11/22/1993, White Male, 5'9", 145 lbs, hazel eyes, brown hair, who resides at 8000 E. 12th Avenue, #7-32, Denver CO 80220.

C.R.S., 18-3-102 (1)(a), First Degree Murder (Class 1 Felony)**

I, Detective Jami Sisneros, 00073, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above-named person(s), are the following

On August 12, 2019 at approximately 4:14 pm the Denver Combined Communications Center received a 911 call from [REDACTED] E 12th Avenue on report of a shooting. When responding officers arrived they learned a [REDACTED] and his [REDACTED] ran to the leasing office and told an employee that [REDACTED] had been shot and she was dead. Officers learned the apartment was number [REDACTED] and went to the apartment where they found an adult female with stab wound(s) to her throat and gunshot wound(s) to her chest. EMS responded and the adult female was pronounced dead at the scene at 4:39 pm by Denver Health Medical Center (DHMC) Doctor McVane. Officers also found a [REDACTED] still asleep and unharmed in the apartment. All [REDACTED] were transported to the hospital for examination and treatment. The victim was tentatively identified as [REDACTED] dob; [REDACTED]/[REDACTED]/2019.

Your Affiant, Detective Jami Sisneros and Detective John Meoni 94005 of the Denver Police Homicide Unit were called out to begin the investigation. Your Affiant and Detective Meoni arrived at the scene and from the front door area your Affiant could see the body of the victim and a black colored shotgun lying on the front living room floor. Officers who cleared the apartment informed Your Affiant they saw a knife in the family room and a case for rifle or shotgun in an upstairs bedroom.

Officers informed your Affiant and Detective Meoni that the [REDACTED] was interviewed on body worn camera. Your Affiant watched the interview. The officer conducting the interview, Officer Valentine, asked who lives in the apartment and [REDACTED] answered, "[REDACTED]" Officers went to the leasing office and learned the victim listed "Sean Landrock" as her emergency contact.

While your Detective Meoni was preparing the search warrant, the [REDACTED], identified as [REDACTED] was released from the hospital and brought to DPD Headquarters to be interviewed by Forensic Interviewer Dulce Solis.

During the interview, [REDACTED] stated that he [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said that Sean [REDACTED] boyfriend. [REDACTED] stated that he was upstairs watching [REDACTED] when he heard [REDACTED].

█████ stated that he went downstairs and saw that ██████. He stated that Sean went upstairs and got a gun from the closet of his (Sean's) room and then ██████ stated that Sean told ██████ "██████████" and told him "██████████". ██████ stated that Sean cleaned the shotgun off with a green towel before he left. He stated that Sean grabbed his keys and left in his grey 4-door car. ██████ stated that Sean's car has a broken back light and a dent in the front.

█████ described Sean as a White male with possibly black hair. Sean has tattoos of a skeleton and bomb on his arm and letters on his upper chest. ██████ stated that Sean had on a blue shirt with a skeleton on it when he left.

Your Affiant showed ██████ a single photo of Sean Landrock, dob: 11/22/1993 and he positively identified him as "Sean" the person ██████

Based on the above stated information your Affiant respectfully requests that this probable cause arrest warrant be approved for the charge of C.R.S., 18-3-102 (1)(a), First Degree Murder (Class 1 Felony) for the suspect identified as Sean Landrock.

Further, pursuant to Rule 41 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, your Affiant is respectfully requesting the approval to have this Affidavit sealed from public release of the information herein contained. Your Affiant is also respectfully requesting the approval to have this Affidavit sealed from public release of the information herein contained due to media coverage of this case, to assure that this case is not compromised, and/or so that witnesses mentioned in this warrant can be protected from any type of early reprisals, so that this investigation can continue.
