I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 07/19/2019 at 8:35 pm at or near the location of 3212 N DEXTER in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

[On 7/19/2019 at approximately 2035 hours officers were called to respond to a shooting in the area of E. 32nd Ave. / N. Dahlia St. The information provided by the dispatcher indicated that a female had been shot 25 - 30 minutes prior. Officers checked the area and were not able to locate a victim.

On 7/19/2019 at about 2055 hours a male who identified himself as, Phillip Bivins (6/30/1974), walked into the District 2 station and notified officers that he had been involved in a shooting at 3212 N Dexter St. Bivins told Officer Bailey (18034) "I was the shooter in a shooting." Bivins advised Officer Bailey that he wanted to turn himself in. Officer Bailey inquired about the location of the incident, when it occurred and who the victim was. In response to these questions, Bivins advised Officer Bailey that the incident occurred at 3212 N. Dexter St., between "11 and 12." Bivins did not offer whether the incident occurred at 1100 hrs on July 19, 2019, 2300 hrs on July 18, 2019. Bivins told Officer Bailey the victim was his wife, Tia Bivins.

Officers advised dispatch of the updated address of the shooting (3212 N. Dexter St.). In order to possibly render aid to the victim, Officer Adam (18023) asked Bivins where the victim was located and if the door to the residence was locked. Bivins stated that the door to the house was locked and that the victim would be inside of the house near the front door.

Officers who responded to the scene confirmed that the door was in fact locked. Officer Bishop (14067) forced entry into the residence through the front door and located the victim unresponsive, laying on her back with dry blood on her head and shoulders. Denver Health paramedics responded to assess the victim and determined she was deceased. The victim was pronounced on 7/19/2019 at 2108 hours by Dr. McVaney.

Bivins was transported to Denver Police Headquarters to be interviewed by Detective Mark Crider. Prior to being questioned, Detective Crider read Bivins a Miranda advisement. Bivins requested to speak with an attorney. Based upon this request, an interview was not conducted.

Bivins was identified by self-admission and by his valid Colorado Driver License [REDACTED].]
