I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 08/22/2022 at 3:30 pm at or near the location of 1000 BLOCK E 14TH AVE in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

[On August 22, 2022, at approximately 3:33 p.m., Officer Adam TANVAS #17092 was flagged down at E. 14th Ave/ N. Downing St. on a shooting which had occurred at E. 14th Ave/ N. Ogden St., which is in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

Officer TANVAS contacted the victim, [REDACTED], suffering from a gunshot wound to his right arm, inside a silver Ford Flex bearing Colorado license plate [REDACTED]. The victim was shot while in the front passenger seat of a silver Ford Flex which was driven by [REDACTED]. The victim was transported to Denver Health Medical Center by ambulance.

A Short time later, the Denver Police Communications Bureau received several calls describing the suspect in the shooting as a black male, 20's, braided hair, wearing a white shirt, grey pants, and black satchel.

Officers located five spent 9mm cartridge casings and one live 9mm cartridge in the 1000 block of E. 14th Ave. Officers located three suspected bullet defects on the rear end of the silver Ford Flex. Officers contacted several witnesses on-scene who observed the shooting and collected written statements.

At approximately 5:06 p.m., Detectives responded to Denver Health Medical Center and spoke with the victim, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Detectives learned [REDACTED] picked [REDACTED] up from his first day at school at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] while driving eastbound on E. 14th Ave at N. Ogden St., observed a party, described as a black male, 20-30 years old, braided hair, wearing black pants, black jacket and a white or grey shirt, walk out into traffic in front of vehicle. [REDACTED] related the male was yelling and screaming at other vehicles and she had to slam on her brakes to stop as he walked out into traffic. [REDACTED] related right after the party walked past the front of her vehicle, she continued to drive away eastbound on E. 14th Ave. As she drove away, she heard several gunshots directly from behind her vehicle and heard [REDACTED] screaming. [REDACTED] related she did not observe who shot at her vehicle.

At approximately 6:57 p.m., Detectives responded to the Denver Police Headquarters to review possible H.A.L.O. footage of the shooting. Detectives observed a possible subject who matched the description of the suspect described by witnesses walking westbound in the 1000 block of E. Colfax Ave wearing a white t-shirt, grey pants, black bag draped over his shoulder and black/white/ red shoes. The male subject was observed on H.A.L.O. walking with a Hispanic or black female wearing a red shirt and had small dog with them.

At approximately 7:18 p.m., Detectives observed a black male who matched the description of the shooting suspect live on H.A.L.O. cameras now wearing a black jacket, grey pants, white t-shirt, and black/white/red shoes standing in the 1400 block of Ogden St. with the female in red accompanied with the dog. Detectives observed the male subject to be wearing the same-colored shoes, pants and white t-shirt observed earlier on H.A.L.O. cameras. Detectives aired the suspect information via Dispatch and the party, identified as Katrell JAMES dob: 05/18/2000 was detained without incident at 1000 E. Colfax Ave. The female party identified as [REDACTED] dob: [REDACTED] was also detained. No gun was recovered on-scene.

Detectives attempted to speak with Mr. JAMES but he requested his lawyer present.

Officers completed a show-up identifications with a witness of the shooting who positively identified Mr. JAMES as the suspect in the shooting.

The Denver Police Crime Scene Unit responded and collected possible gunshot residue (GSR) from Mr. JAMES who was then transported to the Denver Detention Center.]
