I, Officer Blake Bishop, 14067, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above-named person(s), are the following:

Initial Investigation:

On 09-07-2022 at approximately 1615 hours Denver Police Officers responded to 2401 E Colfax Ave in the City and County of Denver on the report of a shooting. While enroute to the location dispatch aired that there were possibly multiple victims struck by gunfire.

Upon arrival officers contacted the first victim, identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED], on the northeast corner of E Colfax Ave / N Josephine St. Officers observed Burt-Harding to have a gunshot wound to left cheek.

Additional responding officers contacted the second victim, identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED], on the northeast side of the Carla Madison Rec Center located at 2401 E Colfax Ave. [REDACTED] was observed to have multiple (possibly 5) gunshot wounds to his left arm, left leg, and abdomen.

Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were transported to [REDACTED] by ambulance.

Officers on scene learned that there were 3 separate physical altercations that occurred in the area prior to the shooting. Officers received cell phone videos of the altercations, as well as multiple witness statements from parties in the area.

Officers located nine (9) spent 9mm cartridge casings and a black "LA" baseball hat with white lettering directly to the southeast of the front door to the 7-Eleven located at 2341 E Colfax Ave. The crime scene was documented, and all evidence was collected by the Denver Police Department Crime Lab.

Officers and Detectives from the Denver Police Department Gang Bureau were called and assigned to interview witnesses to the shooting.

Officer Tana Cunningham 16053 responded to Denver Health Medical Center and contacted the victims. [REDACTED] was unable to complete a detailed statement due to the location of his wounds. Officer Cunningham contacted [REDACTED] who stated the following:

- [REDACTED] was at the rec center with his friends and [REDACTED] stated that he recently had a friend that passed away following a crash during a police chase.
- [REDACTED] stated that a party he knows as [REDACTED] has been disrespecting [REDACTED] deceased friend, which has caused an ongoing Facebook altercation.
- [REDACTED] stated that he was alerted that [REDACTED] was at the rec center and went to locate [REDACTED] to fight [REDACTED]
- [REDACTED] stated he was walking westbound on E Colfax Ave in front of the rec center and observed [REDACTED] near the intersection of E Colfax Ave / N Josephine St walking westbound.
- [REDACTED] stated he called out to [REDACTED] at which time [REDACTED] approached a group of males standing to the south of the 7-Eleven.
- [REDACTED] stated he heard someone yell "Hey" from in front of the rec center. [REDACTED] turned to see who yelled and was immediately struck by gunfire.
- [REDACTED] ran to the northeast corner of the rec center where he was eventually contacted by police.

Officers began to gather surveillance footage from businesses in the area as well as the Denver Police Department High Activity Location Observation cameras.

Sergeant Ed Arnold 99018 contacted witness [REDACTED] who stated that a male with curly hair passed a firearm to a black male wearing a green hooded sweatshirt who fired the firearm several times. [REDACTED] showed Sergeant Arnold still images of surveillance footage from the rec center and identified a black male wearing an olive-green hooded sweatshirt with a black "P" on the front, and black pants as the shooter.

Your Affiant responded to the Denver Police Department Gang Unit and interviewed [REDACTED] who stated the following:

- [REDACTED] detailed two separate physical altercations involving a male known to her as [REDACTED]
- [REDACTED] stated that the second fight was between [REDACTED] and a black male wearing an olive-green colored sweatshirt and black pants.
- [REDACTED] stated that she did not see who was shooting.

Follow-Up Investigation:

On 09-07-2022 Officer Tana Cunningham was assigned Denver Police Department case number 2022-462168 for follow-up investigation.

Officer Cunningham learned that the suspect was seen entering the Carla Madison Rec Center at approximately 1352 hours. Officer Cunningham learned that all parties that enter the rec center are

required to "scan in" using a "My Denver" individual ID. Officer Cunningham learned that 3 parties, entered the rec center at 1352, and the names associated with the "My Denver" ID cards were

[REDACTED] Jalil Mitchell, and [REDACTED] Detective Joey Perez 98003 requested HALO footage from within the Carla Madison Rec Center at 1352 hours at the entrance where IDs are scanned. The footage was uploaded to Evidence.com by HALO personnel.

Your Affiant accessed the uploaded video and observed that at 13:51:46 three black males enter the south entrance to the Carla Madison Rec Center. Your Affiant observed that the first person to check-in was wearing a white t-shirt, black pants and white shoes, this party was later identified as [REDACTED]. The second party that Your Affiant observed check-in was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with "NASA" logos, grey sweatpants, and black shoes, this party was later identified as [REDACTED]. Your Affiant observed that the third party, who was wearing an olive-green hooded sweatshirt with a black "P" on the front, black pants, black shoes, and a black baseball hat with "LA" in white writing, did not use a card to check in but spoke with the clerks at the desk for several seconds. The third party was later identified as Jalil Mitchell 06-15-2006.

Your Affiant received still images of surveillance footage from the 7-Eleven located at 2341 E Colfax Ave and observed Mitchell, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] all walking westbound through the parking lot on the north side of the business. Your Affiant received independent witness cell phone video which showed a physical altercation between two females that were fighting at the northwest corner of the 7-Eleven parking lot. The video showed [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and Mitchell walk southbound in the alley toward E Colfax Ave. Your Affiant observed a fourth involved male, later identified as [REDACTED] who was seen walking with [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and Mitchell. Your Affiant reviewed HALO and 7-Eleven surveillance footage and observed that [REDACTED] was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, multicolored ripped blue jeans and a white belt. It should be noted that [REDACTED] has long curly black hair that is approximately shoulder length.

Your Affiant queried Jalil Mitchell 06-15-2006 through NCIC/CCIC/DMV and found him to have an active Colorado DMV document with an attached photograph. Your Affiant observed the photograph and compared the DMV photograph to the surveillance footage of the suspected shooter. Your Affiant observed Mitchell to have a listed height of 6'01 and a listed weight of 140. Your Affiant observed the known photograph of Jalil Mitchell to have a similar stature and facial structure as the suspect in the surveillance footage.

Your Affiant and Officer Cunningham responded to East High School and met with [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) and [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] was shown several surveillance photographs and identified [REDACTED] as one of the involved parties. [REDACTED] was presented several photographs and identified [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that the male in the olive-green hooded sweatshirt was not an East High School student, but he knows the male as Jhalil, and has contacted Jhalil due to Jhalil being involved in physical altercations with East High School students.

Detective Bruce Kay 04056 conducted a video and audio recorded interview with witness [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was shown a photographic lineup with a known photograph of [REDACTED] randomly assigned to position #4. [REDACTED] selected image #4 and stated he was somewhat confident

with his identification, and stated “#4 kid was hanging out with the shooter for 1 hour or so before incident. During the shooting #4 was standing beside the suspect shooting where I’m somewhat confident that he handed the possible weapon to the shooter. After looking through video cameras I noticed #4 walking around the building after fleeing from the scene of the shooting. #4 was walking by victims observed their condition it seemed all white being on phone.”

██████████ was then shown a photographic lineup related to the suspected shooter, containing a known photograph of Jalil Mitchell randomly assigned to photograph #5. ██████████ went on to state that he was torn between two of the parties, #3 and #5(Mitchell). ██████████ wrote “I’m between #3 + #5 He appeared darker skin color.”

Based upon the above known facts, Your Affiant respectfully requests an arrest warrant be issued for **Jalil Tyearie Wayne Mitchell 06-15-2006** for: C.R.S. 18-3-102(1)(d); 18-2-101 – **Criminal Attempt to Commit Murder in the First Degree**, a Class 2 Felony. C.R.S. 18-3-202(1)(a)(c) – **Assault in the First Degree**, a Class 3 Felony - C.R.S. 18-12-108.5(1)(a) – **Possession of a Handgun by a Juvenile**, a Class 2 Misdemeanor.
