



**AFFIDAVIT AND APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT
AND THE ARREST WARRANT FOR THE PERSON(S) OF:**

**Brandon Louis Sandoval (11/29/2005) a White Male, 5'3", 98 lbs,
Brown Eyes, Black Hair,**

For C.R.S. 18-3-102 (1)(a) Murder in the First Degree a Class 1 Felony

I, Detective Brian Lang #03014, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above-named person(s), are the following:

Your Affiant obtained the following information by personal observations, interviews, witnesses, discussions with fellow officers and by reviewing official police reports of the Denver Police Department.

On **January 11th, 2023**, at approximately **6:20 p.m.**, the Denver Police Communications Bureau received a call of a shooting at 4670 N Peoria Street. This location is within the City and County of Denver.

Upon arrival, officers located the victim, [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]), and witness [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]), with a 1999 Honda Accord (Colorado License Plate [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] was suffering from a single gunshot wound to her left side and was transported to University Hospital in critical condition. The witness was transported to Denver Police Headquarters for an interview.

After further investigation, a scene was located in the 5400 Block Atchinson Way, which is also within the City and County of Denver. Officers secured the scene on Atchinson Way, and the vehicle was towed to Denver Police Headquarters, where it was placed in the Vehicle Processing Bay of the Denver Crime Lab where it could be processed.

Your Affiant responded to Denver Police Headquarters, where an interview was conducted with the witness, [REDACTED]. She related that she and [REDACTED], the victim, were driving from their house to [REDACTED] house in Commerce City, when she decided she wanted to sell some "Cake Bars" AKA THC vape pens.

[REDACTED] said that her [REDACTED] friend had a friend that wanted to buy them from her. She said that neither her nor her [REDACTED] had ever met this person, but obtained his Snapchat, UN: alonso50. She said that she was communicating with him via the Snapchat application. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said that she communicated with him through her own account, UN: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said that suspect had sent her an address range to meet, which was 5517-5599 Atchison Way, where she agreed to meet him. She said that she drove to the Montebello

neighborhood and was unfamiliar with the area, so she lost her way. She was driving slowly near the park, when she saw she was being approached by two parties who were approaching from the park.

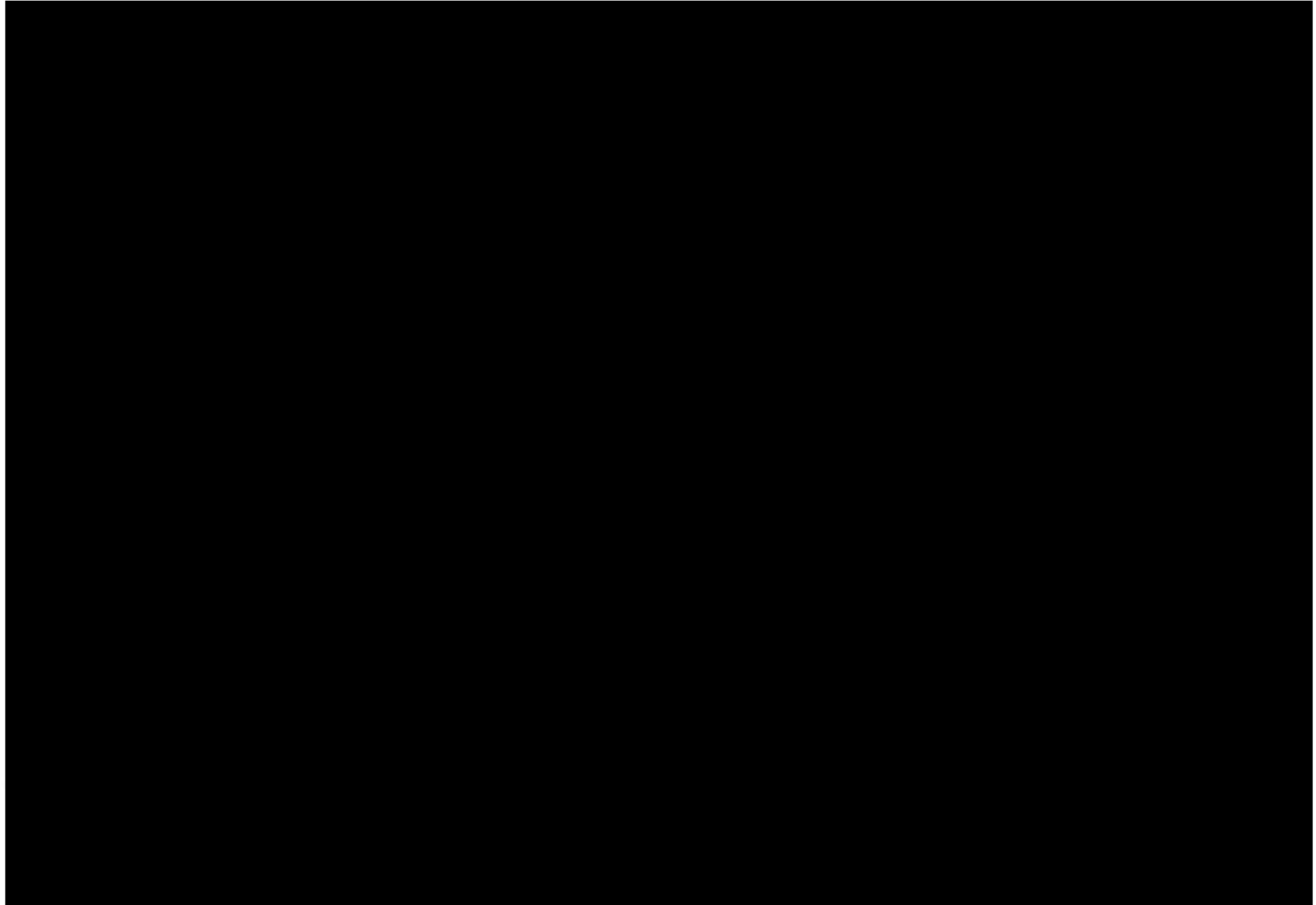
██████████ said the suspect approached her vehicle. ██████████ described the suspect as a teenage white male, wearing a gray "beanie", black pants, black jacket, gray shirt, 4'11"-5'4" tall, skinny with blue or green eyes. ██████████ said the suspect approached her window (driver's side) and pointed a gun at her head. ██████████ described the gun was pushed up against her head. At this point ██████████ said she threw the THC cartridges out of the car and began to drive away, losing traction on the ice. As she lost traction, the suspect grabbed onto the frame of her door and was reaching into the car through the window, while still pointing the gun at her. ██████████ said that ██████████ then reached over and began hitting the suspect to get him to let go, which is when she heard a gunshot and the suspect let go.

██████████ said that ██████████ said she was shot and couldn't breathe. ██████████ said she drove to the area of 4670 N. Peoria Street looking for a hospital, but then ██████████ passed out, so she pulled over to render aid and called 911.

On **January 12, 2023**, at **6:55 am**, the victim was pronounced deceased by University Hospital, Dr. DOUIN from injuries she sustained from the gunshot.

On **January 12, 2023**, Detective Andrew LANDON #13077, was granted a search warrant for Snapchat account "alanso50", from The Honorable Judge Kelly CHERRY. Detective LANDON served the warrant to Snapchat.

On **January 12, 2023**, your Affiant received a Denver Crime Laboratory report from the Latent Print Unit regarding shoe impressions that were obtained from the crime scene. The report was completed by Forensic Scientist Jan LeMAY. The report read as follows: "Impressions FW-1(1A, 1B) correspond in outsole design to the Nike Air Force 1 shoe. Those class characteristics observed in the impressions could have also come from another shoe with the same outsole design. The color and upper design of the shoes may vary, please use this as a reference for the outsole design only."



On **January 13, 2023**, Detective LANDON began receiving information back from Snapchat regarding the account for "alanso50". Detective LANDON provided the information to your Affiant for review. While reviewing the Snapchat information for "alanso50", your Affiant located a photograph of a Colorado Identification Card for Brandon Louis SANDOVAL, dob: 11/29/2005. The address listed on the Colorado Identification Card for Brandon Louis SANDOVAL was 5534 Crystal Way, Denver, CO 80239. The description provided on the Colorado Identification Card for Brandon Louis SANDOVAL is 5'3" tall, 98 pounds, green eyes and brown hair. This information matches the description provided by [REDACTED]

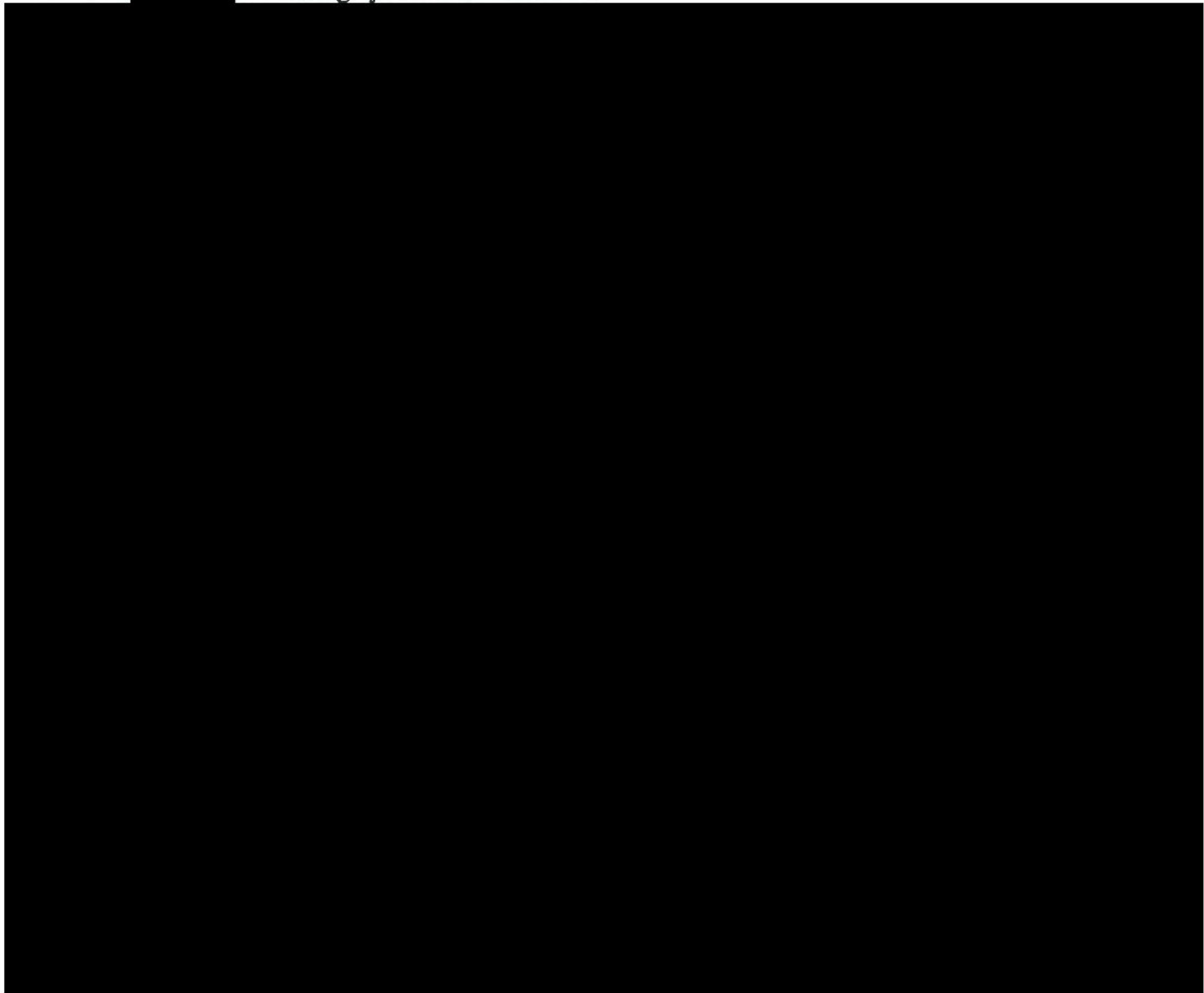
Your Affiant requested the assistance of Crime Analyst, Craig SPINGARN with reviewing the records received from Snapchat. While reviewing the records your Affiant was informed that during the time of the shooting, Snapchat account "alanso50", which is associated to Brandon Louis SANDOVAL, was located in the area of Falcon Park, and the east border for Falcon Park is the 5400 Block Atchinson Way, where the shooting occurred.

Further review of Snapchat account "alonso50", which is associated to Brandon Louis SANDOVAL, shows several instances where it is used in the direct area of 5534 Crystal Way, Denver, CO 80239.

Your Affiant was able to view several messages between Snapchat account "alonso50", which is associated to Brandon Louis SANDOVAL, and Snapchat account "[REDACTED]", (who is unknown at this time).

The messages between "alonso50" and "[REDACTED]" are located below. "alonso50" is in the blue text box and "[REDACTED]" is in the gray text box:



On January 13, 2023, [REDACTED] viewed a photographic lineup that consisted of 6 individual photos. Brandon Louis SANDOVAL, dob: 11/29/2005 was randomly placed in position #3. Upon viewing the photographic lineup [REDACTED] stated it was between #1 and #3.

[redacted] stated the following about #3 "He looks younger than others. He looks similar to the kid that shot [redacted]" [redacted] stated she was somewhat confident in her identification.

Based on the aforementioned information, Your Affiant respectfully requests that a probable cause warrant be issued for, **Brandon Louis Sandoval (11/29/2005)**
