Denver DA Charges Oliver Baclayon with Murder

DENVER—On January 21, 2023, Denver Police Department officers responded to a 911 call of a stabbing. Upon arrival, officers found 29-year-old Oliver Baclayon on the front porch of a residence and a deceased 61-year-old woman inside.

Today, prosecutors with the Denver DA's Office announced that a criminal case against Oliver Baclayon was opened. He is charged with one count of murder in the first degree (F1). This is Denver District Court case number 23CR000427.
