 I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 3/21/23 at 9:01  am  pm at or near the location of E. 30<sup>th</sup> Ave. and N. William's St. in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

Statement of Probable Cause       Affidavit for Arrest Warrant

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

On March 21, 2023, at approximately 8:48 p.m. Denver Combined Communications received a Shot Spotter notification that there was gun fire detected in the 3000 Block N. Gilpin St / N. William St Alley with 10 rounds detected. Then shortly after the Shot Spotter detected an additional 26 round of gun fire. Officer [redacted] and Officer [redacted], who were working as partners in fully marked Denver Police patrol car 231A, responded to the area in their full Denver police uniform. Due to the number of rounds fired, and his knowledge of the high crime rate in the area, Office [redacted] requested additional officers for cover. Upon arrival Officer [redacted] and Officer [redacted] observed 3 black males walking east on E. 30th Ave toward N. Williams St. The males saw officers and walked southeast and two of them turned their backs on officers next to a fence with foliage near it, and it appeared that they were pulling something from their wait bands. Officer [redacted] requested that the males stop. Two of the men, later identified as [redacted] dob: [redacted] and [redacted] dob: [redacted], stopped and complied with Officer [redacted] commands. The third male, later identified as [redacted] dob: [redacted] 2007, did not comply with Officer [redacted] commands and continued to walk east bound. Officer [redacted] started walking after [redacted] telling him to stop walking. Officer [redacted] observed that [redacted] had something heavy in the front pocket of his sweatshirt weighing it down. Officer [redacted] feared that it was a firearm. [redacted] began to reach into his hoodie pocket and Officer [redacted] became fearful that he was reaching for a gun. Officer [redacted] grabbed [redacted] elbows from behind and tried to squeeze his elbows together in an attempt to stop him from reaching into his front pocket. [redacted] put his right hand fully into the front pocket of his hoodie, leaned to the left and fired a shot at Officer [redacted]. Officer [redacted] wrapped his arms fully around [redacted] torso and arms, used his leg to sweep [redacted] legs and took him to the ground. [redacted] still had his right hand in his pocket where the gun was. Office [redacted] called for emergency police cover advising that shots were fired, believing that Officer [redacted] had possibly been shot. Officer [redacted] became fearful that [redacted] was going to shoot at him again, so he pointed his gun at [redacted] and told him not to move, while still using his weight to hold [redacted] on the ground. Officer [redacted] arrived on scene and assisted Officer [redacted] by pulling of [redacted] right arm from his pocket. Officers then placed [redacted] into custody. [redacted] had a Glock 19X, 17 round

capacity, which had malfunctioned and had a spent casing in the gun and a Glock 30S with a suspected auto sear switch, which makes the gun fully automatic, in his front sweatshirt pocket. Officers found 2 additional guns in the foliage near the fence where [redacted] and [redacted] turned their backs and reached for their waist bands when officers arrived. Detectives attempted to conduct an interview with [redacted] with [redacted] present, but he declined to interview.
