I, Detective Ernest Sandoval 06154, the Affiant, state under oath that the facts known to the Affiant which establish probable cause to believe that a criminal offense was committed, and that the offense was committed by the above named person(s), are the following:

On **August 6, 2021**, at approximately **10:32 p.m.**, the Denver Police Department's Communication's Bureau received a 911 call stating that someone had just been shot at 22nd and Wazee.

Upon responding officers' arrival, they located a male suffering from a gunshot wound in the parking lot near Gate A. This male, [REDACTED] was suffering from a gunshot wound to the groin. Officer's also located another victim who was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. This male was identified as [REDACTED]

At approximately 10:58 p.m., your Affiant received a phone call from Sergeant MURPHY to respond on the homicide. Your Affiant responded to Denver Police Headquarters to interview witnesses.

At approximately 12:16 a.m., your Affiant interviewed [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she works with [REDACTED] and that earlier in the day prior to fans entering the stadium, [REDACTED] was involved in a verbal altercation with two males. [REDACTED] said that one of the males was [REDACTED] and the other male was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that the argument started possibly over [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] talking to the same girl, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] left with the two males from concession stand 312 and that she did not know where they went but that [REDACTED] came back to get his backpack and attempted to leave. [REDACTED] convinced [REDACTED] to stay in the concession stand and work. [REDACTED] stated that a few minutes later the two males arrived at concession 312 and started talking to [REDACTED] another employee working concession 312. [REDACTED] heard the two males talking and said "They can't keep my name out of their mouth." [REDACTED] approached [REDACTED] and was arguing again. When the game had ended [REDACTED] was walking out with [REDACTED] to go home when [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he could not walk with her because he needed to handle some issues. [REDACTED] hugged [REDACTED] and a couple minutes later heard gunshots. Your Affiant showed a single photograph of [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]. Your affiant showed the photograph to [REDACTED] and she was unable to identify the photograph as [REDACTED].

Your Affiant was able to retrieve surveillance video from Coors Field which captured the shooting. The victim is observed arguing with a black male in black clothing. A short time later a dark-skinned male wearing black pants and a light-colored hoodie appears and then fires a gun striking the victim. The victim runs down the stairs as the suspect continues to shoot at him. The victim drops a backpack and falls to the ground. While on the ground the suspect runs down the stairs and stands approximately 5 feet from the victim and fires four to five more shots at the victim.

Your Affiant provided Detective Johnson with a photograph of an individual with the name [REDACTED] and requested Detective Johnson contact [REDACTED] the main company who contracts with the temporary employment, in an attempt to identify the individual, who was reported to be a temporary employee at Coors Field in concessions. Your Affiant learned the following from Detective Johnson:

At **10:20 a.m.** Detective Johnson met with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and showed them the photograph, however none were personally familiar with the individual. [REDACTED] obtained check in/assignment logs, which are used to identify and check in contract workers for the companies Instaworks and Laborworks, which provide staffing for events for [REDACTED], and was able to identify an individual on the sheets by the name of [REDACTED]. She related that he had worked section 127P the previous evening. She stated the logs were kept in order to reconcile check in's for workers to assist with tracking hours and paying them for their work. [REDACTED] stated that she had contacted Instaworks earlier in the morning in an attempt to identify another individual associated with this case, [REDACTED] however she had not heard back from them. She stated she would continue to attempt to contact them to also identify [REDACTED].

At approximately **11:45 a.m.** Detective Johnson spoke with [REDACTED] of the Human Resources Office at Coors Field. She related that on August 6, 2021, while working to check in staff, she checked in an individual who provided the name [REDACTED] to her. The check in process consists of the issuance of a wrist band that has a unique number on it which is then associated with their provided name on the check in form used to calculate their wages. She related she wrote the name [REDACTED] on the check-in/assignment sheet and issued him a wrist band. She stated that they do not require an identification so she could only identify him by the name he provided her. She described him as a black male wearing a green hoodie, black pants, and black shoes.

Later that evening, at what was determined to be **7:40 p.m.** she related that the same individual came downstairs and complained of being ill and not feeling well. She related he was escorted to the room she was in to turn in his wrist band, and then was escorted out of the building by another employee. [REDACTED] was present in the video monitor room at Coors Field and identified video of the individual whose name she was told was [REDACTED] when he came downstairs to say he didn't feel well, when he entered her office to turn in his wristband and when he was being escorted from the building, accompanied by a female employee in a red shirt. In that video, the individual identified as [REDACTED] was seen wearing what appeared to be a long sleeved hoodie underneath a light gray button up shirt, which [REDACTED] described as being issued to him when he checked in for work, black pants and black shoes. As [REDACTED] was being escorted from the building, he was observed removing the light gray shirt and throwing it in a large bin in the hallway as he was leaving. Video from the camera labeled

Stair 12 showed ██████████ and the female employee in the red shirt exit an internal door into the stairwell area. The sweatshirt ██████████ was wearing had the word "Nike" with its swish symbol in large white letters on the front of the hoodie. ██████████ then exits the building via an external door to the parking lots.

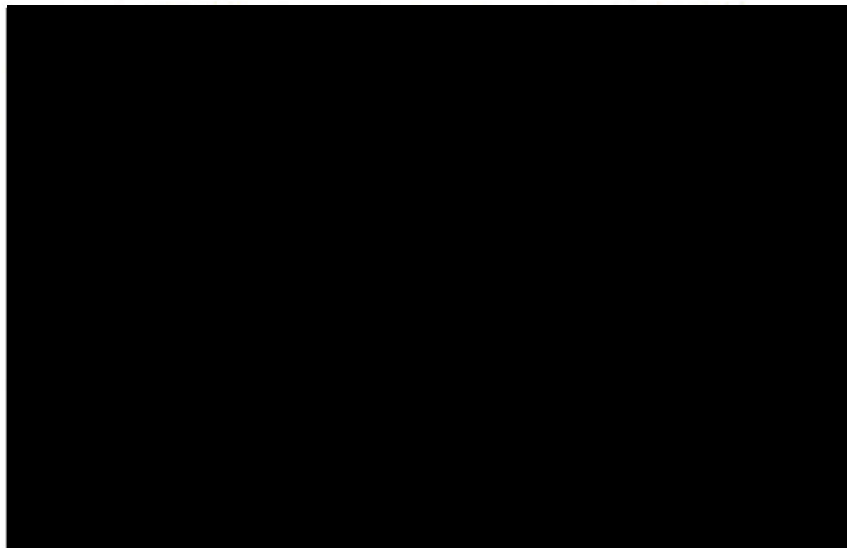


At approximately **11:56 a.m.** Detective Johnson received information from ██████████ about the check in/out times for three individuals on **August 6, 2021**: the victim, ██████████ (checked in at **2:36 p.m.** – checked out at **10:19:42 p.m.**), an involved individual, ██████████ (checked in at **3:12 p.m.**) and ██████████ (checked in at **4:13 p.m.**). However, there were no official check out times provided for ██████████. ██████████ was described by witnesses as having been wearing a black t-shirt, a black "do-rag" on his head, black jeans and black shoes. Detective Johnson was able to locate video from the camera labeled "Stair Exit 10", which is the camera that covered the area where the contract parties would check in for their shifts. Detective Johnson located video of an individual matching ██████████ description checking in at approximately **3:12 p.m.** wearing the described clothing:

Your Affiant was able to locate a [REDACTED] in law enforcement records who was involved in a traffic accident in Denver on July 17, 2021. Your Affiant was able to locate body worn camera footage from the incident and found the person in the video was the same person observed at Coors Field providing the name [REDACTED]

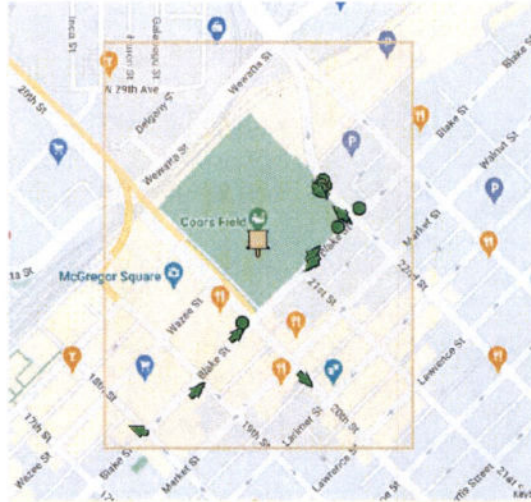


Your Affiant was able to speak with witness [REDACTED] who stated that he was leaving the field at about 10:25 p.m., when he was going up the stairs near Gate A. He saw “a tall guy”, who he believed to be the leader of the group, giving orders. This appeared to be organized because the “tall guy” was saying things like “you go here, you go there.” [REDACTED] described all of the parties wearing black shirts. [REDACTED] said he was scared and started to run. [REDACTED] said he ran to the Blue Moon Brewery (Sandlot Brewery) where he felt safe. In another video your Affiant was able to view who appears to be [REDACTED], handing the gun off to [REDACTED], prior to [REDACTED] shooting the victim.

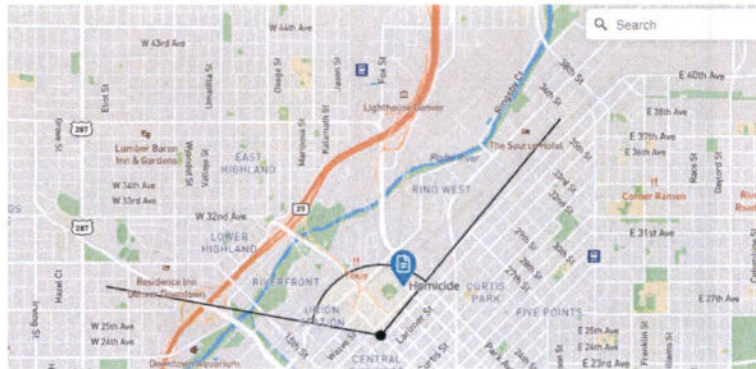
During the course of the investigation, your affiant was aware that a third person was in the above pictured photograph and that it appeared that either [REDACTED] or this third unknown person had brought the gun and handed the gun off to [REDACTED]. Your affiant was made aware that [REDACTED] had spoke to a phone number, [REDACTED]. This phone communicated with [REDACTED] on 08/06/2021 at 8:44 p.m., 8:47 p.m., and 11:56 p.m. This phone was attributed to Treneil MCNEAL. It was found that Mr. MCNEAL was on GPS ankle monitor from Arapahoe County for a previous case. Your affiant received the GPS points for Mr. MCNEAL, and he arrives to Coors Field at approximately 10:10 p.m. and leaves at approximately 10:35 p.m. This would match with the time we have our third unknown person meeting up with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].



Your affiant then received call detail records with timing advance data from Detective Andrew LANDON. Detective LANDON was investigating Mr. MCNEAL in a separate incident where it is likely the same firearm used on this homicide was used at 3501 Wazee St. In this incident Detective LANDON is investigating Mr. MCNEAL for shooting a security guard at a nightclub/bar. A NIBIN comparison was done between shell casings found at the Coors Field homicide and shell casings found at Detective LANDON's nightclub shooting. The comparison yielded a likely match between the guns from both crimes. When your affiant reviewed the call detail records for the cellular number that Mr.

MCNEAL has previously provided to law enforcement, your affiant observed an incoming call at 10:11 p.m. to Mr. MCNEAL. This call shows he was in the area of Coors Field at 10:11 p.m.



Your affiant reviewed the surveillance footage for the homicide that occurred at Coors Field and in the photograph where the third unknown accomplice hands the gun to ██████████ the unknown person appears to match the physical description of Mr. MCNEAL. Mr. MCNEAL is shorter than ██████████ but taller than ██████████. Also ██████████ is heavier than ██████████

The firearm utilized in this incident and the shooting at 3501 Wazee St was ultimately recovered on September 10, 2022, in Aurora, Colorado. The person that the firearm was recovered from does not appear to have any connection to ██████████, ██████████ or Mr. MCNEAL. Your affiant is aware that firearms will be traded, sold or exchanged for other items, especially when the firearm has been utilized in a crime.

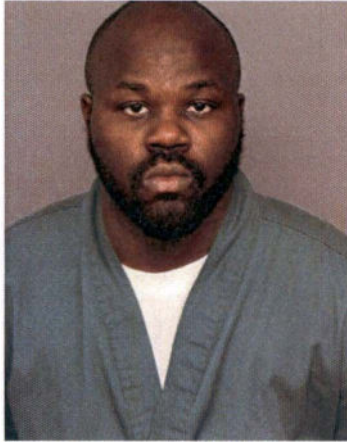
Your affiant located two previous felony convictions for Mr. MCNEAL.

-Denver County Court on District Case# 2021CR4088 for Possession of a Weapon by a Previous Offender, as a class 6 Felony, with a sentence date of 10/14/2021.

-Denver County Court on District Case# 2019CR1258 for Possession of a Controlled Substance 18-18-403.5, as a class 4 Drug Felony, with a sentence date of 04/22/2019.

Based on this report Your Affiant respectfully requests an arrest warrant be issued for Treneal MCNEAL 05/09/1997, for First Degree Murder as a Class 1 Felony and Possession of a Weapon by a Previous Offender as a Class 5 Felony, to further this investigation.
