SUPPORTING AFFIDAVIT FOR AT LARGE ARREST WARRANT	

I, Detective Marty Smith, # 91016, of lawful age do swear upon my oath to the facts set forth below and on five continuation page(s):

Your affiant, Detective Marty Smith, #91016, a Police Officer with the Denver Police Department, was assigned to investigate allegations of: FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY, in violation of 18-4-202(1); CRIME OF VIOLENCE, in violation of 18-1.3-406(2)(a)(I)(A); SEXUAL ASSAULT, in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(5); SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING, in violation of 18-3-302(1),(3); by Jason Keith Groshart against [REDACTED] on DPD Case Number 200414576.

On March 30, 2004, Denver Police Officer Jode Sprague, 95052, received a call to [REDACTED] on a report of a Burglary/Sexual Assault. Upon arrival, Officer Sprague made contact with [REDACTED] and the following account of events was reported.

On March 30, 2004, [REDACTED] left work early due to a migraine headache and subsequently went to her residence, which is located at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] took all of her clothes off and put on a robe. [REDACTED] then fell asleep within her bedroom, but was later awoken at 5:58 p.m., by the sound of her dog aggressively barking. It was at this point that [REDACTED] noticed the suspect within her bedroom that was dressed all in black, including a black mask over his face and a pair of black gloves. [REDACTED] further noticed that this suspect had a pair of handcuffs attached to his belt area and was also armed with a small silver barreled handgun, that was mostly black in color.

Alarmed at the suspects presence, [REDACTED] told the suspect to leave and offered her television and other possessions in exchange for his departure. The suspect declined her offer and stated he was staying as he pulled the bedcovers off [REDACTED].

Next, the suspect put the handgun in [REDACTED] face and ordered her to turn over. While in this position, the suspect removed her robe and placed the handcuffs onto [REDACTED] wrists, behind her back, the suspect then placed a black mask over her head and face and placed her dog into a closet. Again, [REDACTED] pleaded for the suspect to take her possessions and leave. Next, the suspect placed [REDACTED] on her back and spread her legs apart. At first, [REDACTED] held her legs together tightly and kicked at the suspect. This made the suspect upset to the point where he shoved the handgun underneath [REDACTED] chin and stated, "Is this worth dying for?" After [REDACTED] communicated that it was not, the suspect spread her legs apart and now began to fondle, kiss, and digitally penetrate [REDACTED] vagina. The suspect forced his semi-erect penis inside of [REDACTED] and engaged in vaginal intercourse with her to the point of ejaculation.

At the conclusion of the unwanted sexual contact, the suspect stated to [REDACTED] "Okay. We are going to shower." The suspect led her into the bathroom and turned on the water. Both the suspect and [REDACTED] entered the shower. The suspect put soap on [REDACTED] chest and back area prior to rinsing her off. After the suspect finished with the shower, he first dried [REDACTED] off and then himself with a towel.

The suspect then had [REDACTED] stand in her bedroom while he re-dressed himself. Once dressed, the suspect took a trash bag from bathroom. After retrieving the trash bag, the suspect placed [REDACTED] bed linens and the towel inside of it.

Prior to departing, the suspect put [REDACTED] inside of her closet and removed both the mask and handcuffs that he had placed on her. The suspect further instructed [REDACTED] to remain within the closet for five minutes. [REDACTED] waited for only one minute and then went to call the police immediately.

While waiting for the arrival of responding Officers, [REDACTED] had some vaginal discharge, and she collected the fluid within the base of a plastic suction cup/container. [REDACTED] further noted that her bathrobe also had some fluid transfer on it from when she placed it on after the assault.

Although [REDACTED] was masked during this episode, she further described the suspect as a short (5'4 to 5'07) white male, slight build (130 to 160lbs) with no accent and approximately 18-25 years old.

Also of note was that [REDACTED] recalled that the suspect mentioned to her that she did not have her home alarm system turned on and that he has committed this type of offense before.

The DPD Crime Lab responded and collected evidence and processed the crime scene.

[REDACTED] was transported to Denver General Hospital and completed a sex assault examination.

On March 31, 2004, Sex Crimes Detective Anthony Parisi, 89028, was assigned this case for a follow-up investigation. The victim, [REDACTED], responded to DPD Headquarters and she conducted a video recorded interview with Detective Parisi.

On April 1, 2004, Detective Parisi sent a Lab Request to the DPD Crime Lab, requesting that the [REDACTED] sexual assault examination kit be analyzed for the presence of semen. The request also included the suction cup, which contained an unknown fluid. Testing was also requested for the bathrobe that [REDACTED] put on after the assault.

On April 7, 2004, Detective Parisi received the Crime Lab results of victim [REDACTED] sexual assault examination, as well as the analysis that was conducted on the unknown fluid within the suction cup and recovered bathrobe. According to (now deceased) Forensic Scientist Ted Davelis, semen and spermatozoa were detected on victim [REDACTED] vaginal swabs and vaginal smear slides, respectively. Blood and semen were also present within the recovered suction cup and on victim [REDACTED] bathrobe. The Crime Lab report indicates a DNA extraction and analysis would be conducted on the semen stains for submission to CBI and entry into the national CODIS database to determine if a match exists.

The DNA profile that was extracted from the above-mentioned evidence, was uploaded into the CODIS database. There was no match identified.

On May 18, 2004, this case was carried as Inactive, not cleared.

On October 18, 2006, Cold Case Detective Barb Wimer, badge no. 96004, reviewed this case. [REDACTED] The case was accepted for filing as a John Doe case, with the specific DNA profile of the suspect listed as the named defendant. The case was assigned case number 06 CR 6594.

On Friday, March 18, 2022, Your Affiant, Detective Smith was assigned this case for a follow-up investigation. Detective Smith met with members of the DPD Crime Lab on Monday March 21, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., to be briefed on the current status of this case.

The case remained unsolved from 2004 until 2022 when Jason Groshart, dob: 10/17/1972, was identified as a possible suspect using forensic genetic genealogy techniques.

On Thursday, March 24, 2022, at 1:20 p.m., Your Affiant spoke with victim [REDACTED] on the phone. [REDACTED] said she would respond to DPD Headquarters on Monday, March 28, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. for a video recorded interview.

Your Affiant learned that Jason Groshart, dob: 10/17/1972, was arrested by Adams County on October 7, 2007, for carrying a concealed weapon. Your Affiant sent Adams County Records a request asking for the book-in photo from that arrest.

On Monday, March 28, 2022, at 11:00 a.m., [REDACTED] arrived at DPD Headquarters. At 11:10 a.m., Your Affiant began a video recorded interview with [REDACTED] Your Affiant presented a book-in photo dated October 7, 2007, of the suspect, Jason Groshart, dob: 10/17/1972 to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] indicated she did not know that person, and she was certain she never had consensual

sex with that person. [REDACTED] also said she has never known anyone named Jason Groshart.

On September 24, 2022, three surreptitious DNA samples were collected from Jason Groshart, dob: 10/17/1972. The samples were placed into the DPD Property Bureau. Those samples were submitted to the Denver Crime Lab for DNA analysis.

On September 27, 2022, Forensic Scientist Eric Duvall advised Your Affiant that the DNA profile developed from the surreptitious collection, belonging to Jason Groshart, matches the DNA profile which was developed from evidence collected from this sexual assault investigation.

Your Affiant is requesting that this arrest warrant for Jason Groshart, dob: 10/17/1972, be approved and issued, so that this investigation can continue.

Based on the foregoing, your affiant respectfully requests that an At Large Warrant be issued for the arrest of Jason Keith Groshart, DOB: 10/17/1972 for: FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY, in violation of 18-4-202(1) CRIME OF VIOLENCE, in violation of 18-1.3-406(2)(a)(I)(A) SEXUAL ASSAULT, in violation of 18-3-402(1)(a),(5) SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING, in violation of 18-3-302(1),(3)


